by Max Showaiter, lyrics by Peter Walker. Joe Layton, directed the Broadway run.

'H-a-double r-i-g-a-n spells "Harrigan" '. I remember my dad singing this first line from the George M Cohan song. Until I saw 'Harrigan 'n Hart', I had no idea it was about one-half of a famous late 19th century vaudeville team, Edward Harrigan. The other half of the team was Tony Hart, played by Mark in both the Connecticut and Broadway runs.

Some of the songs featured, such as 'Mulligan Guard' and 'I Love to Follow a Band' are vintage vaudeville material. New songs and sketches were blended in, relating the history of the partnership, though certain facts were downplayed. An interesting note: combining story-telling, singing and dancing, Harrigan began what eventually evolved as the Broadway musical.

Quick thinking by his co-star, Harry Groener, prevented him from sliding off the stage. Only the rather horrified face on Groener had anyone realizing that the grab was not part of the performance. 


## Notes from the Editor




Online and looking for something fun to do? MSN.com will be having an interview/ quiz with Mark on their Outsmart section.


